#### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

##### RESTRAINTS

DO NOT use on trees during the growing season (start of flowering to end of harvest).

DO NOT apply to wounds showing brown staining

DO NOT apply on wet foggy days as product will not dry.

For **brush application** to pruning wounds on apples, apricots, plums, peaches, ornamentals to reduce the incidence and extent of fungal invasion.

Garrison Rapid Pruning Wound Dressing Fungicide is not for use in pruning gun applicators.

#### FUNGICIDE RESISTANT WARNING

**GROUP 3 28 FUNGICIDES**

Garrison Rapid Pruning Wound Dressing Fungicide (GARRISON) is a combination of DMI and multi-site activity fungicide. For fungicide resistance management GARRISON is both a Group 3 and a Group 28 fungicide. Some naturally occurring individual fungi resistant to GARRISON and Group 3 and/or Group 28 fungicides may exist through normal genetic variability in any fungal population. The resistant individuals can eventually dominate the fungal population if these fungicides are used repeatedly. These resistant fungi will not be controlled by GARRISON or other Group 3 and/or Group 28 fungicides, thus resulting in a reduction in efficacy and possible yield loss.

**MIXING** Stir thoroughly before use.

**APPLICATION** Never thin with water, as product will not work. Apply undiluted product thickly to dry wound surface with paint brush. Brushes should be washed out in water after use. Reseal container after use to prevent skin formation.

**PROTECTION OF WILDLIFE, FISH, CRUSTACEANS AND ENVIRONMENT** DO NOT contaminate streams, rivers or waterways with chemical or used containers.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL** Store in the closed, original container in a cool, well ventilated area. DO NOT store for prolonged periods in direct sunlight. Triple or preferably pressure rinse containers before disposal. Add rinsings to the spray tank. DO NOT dispose of undiluted chemical on site. If recycling, replace cap and return clean containers to recycler or designated collection point. If not recycling break, crush or puncture container and bury in containers in a local authority landfill. If no landfill is available, bury the containers below 500mm in a disposal pit specifically marked and set up for this purpose clear of waterways, vegetation and roots. Empty containers and product should not be burnt.

**SAFETY DIRECTIONS** Will irritate the eyes and skin. Avoid contact with eyes and skin. DO NOT inhale vapour. When opening the container and using the product, wear face shield or goggles, elbow length PVC gloves. Wash hands after use and after days use, wash face shield, goggles and gloves.
