## 4 First Aid Measures

#### **General Information:**

## 7 Handling and Storage

## **Precautions for Safe Handling:**

Always wash hands before smoking, eating, drinking or using the toilet. Wash contaminated clothing and other protective equipment before storage or re-use. Provide eyewash fountains and safety showers in close proximity to points of potential exposure.

## **Conditions for Safe Storage:**

Store in a cool, dry and well ventilated area. Keep container tightly closed when not in use. Protect from heat, sparks, open flames and other sources of ignition. Keep away from oxidising agents, acids, bases, dicloran, calcium polysulfide and ammonia.
